New Book in Ladino –Djudeo Espanypl

The book "Ofisios" is Asher Amado's twelfth book, focusing on working professions.

Asher Amado, an engineer in his profession, born in Israel and living in Hod- Hasharon, is a part of a Spanish heritage immigrated to Israel from Edirne, Turkey.

In his book, Asher Amado describes professions which have been a great part of the daily life in the past, such as water courier, milk distributor, knives sharpener, Malabi seller, bread trader and more, aside to modern professions such as cellular technician, drones operator, electronic engineer and more.

The book "Ofisios" is written in a gentle way, matched through photos, paintings and titles that match for reading of 7 years old, all through 107 years old who speak the language of Ladino or Spanish, or not.

The book "Ofisios" is an original, modern, experiential book combining flavors of the past and present, describing professions that existed since the expulsion from Spain and Portugal in 1492 until nowadays.

Amado says the book is another prolonged link meant for the preservation of the Ladino language heritage that accompanies us with loyalty over 500 years and could be used as a source of comparison between professions of the past and future, and as an inspiration for the future's creative professions.
